Job Description - Senior Auditor

The Office of the Utah State Auditor has an opening for a Senior Auditor. The position is currently open as a full time position.

A Senior Auditor in the Office of the Utah State Auditor is responsible for leading audits, planning financial audit procedures, identifying risk areas, evaluating audit scope/objectives and organizing the audit to meet rules/objectives. The Senior Auditor is also responsible for supervising the audit team and preparing audit reports.

Desired skills include ability to:

- Conduct audits
- Plan financial audit procedures
- Understand organization objectives, structure, policies, processes, internal controls, and external regulations
- Identify risk areas and evaluate audit scope and objectives
- Organize audit to meet rules and objectives
- Analyze audit data, prepare report findings, interpret results and identify recommendations
- Write high quality correspondence, reports and other needed documents concerning the audit and audit results
- Supervise audit team personnel during audits
- Train, monitor and evaluate the performance of audit team personnel
- Propose, prepare and present in-office training
- Continue to maintain a high level of expertise in relevant audit Standards

Qualifications: Candidates must have a CPA license and 3+ years of experience conducting financial audits in accordance with Government Auditing Standards and conducting compliance audits in accordance with OMB Circular A-133. Qualified candidates will demonstrate advanced understanding of audit skills with the ability to perform all types of audit tests.

The Utah State Auditor is a Constitutional Officer of the State of Utah, elected directly by the state's citizens every 4 years. The role of the Utah State Auditor is authorized in Article VII, Section 15 of the Utah Constitution.
