Dear Mr. Lydolph:

This letter is in response to your GRAMA requests dated November 5, 2013 in which you requested the following records:

“Any and all records pertaining to Adam Ferre” and  
“Any and all records pertaining to Angie Ferre.”

Your request has been denied because of the following reasons:

- Utah Code § 63G-2-305(16) classifies as “protected” “records of a governmental audit agency relating to an ongoing or planned audit until the final audit is released.”
- Utah Code § 63G-2-305(10) classifies as “protected” “records created or maintained for ... audit purposes, ... if release of the records: (b) reasonably could be expected to interfere with audits.”

Pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-2-401, you have the right to appeal the denial of this request to the chief administrative officer, John Dougall, Utah State Auditor. Your notice of appeal must be submitted within 30 days of the above denial date and must include your name, mailing address, daytime telephone number, and an explanation of the relief sought. You may also include any supporting information with your notice of appeal. Your appeal may be submitted to the address listed on our letterhead below.
