This email is in response to your GRAMA request dated July 23, 2019 in which you requested the following records:

Please provide all records records [sic] related to strongerfutures.utah.gov or the Tax Restructuring and Equalization Task Force,, as more fully detailed below:

- Provide all records identifying any person, agency, entity, or group involved in commissioning, producing, approving, or distributing any strongerfutures.utah.gov materials including, without limitation, the website, pamphlets, statistics, graphics, videos, question cards, comment cards, etc. (the "**SFU.gov Materials**").
- Provide all records related to the cost of production of any SFU.gov Materials including, without limitation, contracts, budgets, invoices, statements, canceled checks, etc.
- Provide all records memorializing payments made to any person or entity involved, in any manner, in the production or distribution of any SFU.gov Materials.
- Provide a copy of all written communications to or from the Office of the State Auditor or its agents, employees, directors, or officers, in any way related to the Tax Restructuring and Equalization Task Force, strongerfutures.utah.gov, SFU.gov Materials, or HB441 (2019 General Session).

The Office of the State Auditor does not have any records responsive to the first three bullets of your request. However, we do have records responsive to the 4th bullet of your request. These records are attached to this email.

It should be noted that some of the documents referenced in the attached email communications are drafts and, thus, are considered "protected" based upon Utah Code 63G-2-305(22). However, the final versions of most of the draft documents referenced are included in the attachments to this letter.

Pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-2-401, you have the right to appeal the denial of the protected documents noted above to the chief administrative officer, John Dougall, Utah State Auditor. Your notice of appeal must be submitted within 30 days of the above denial date and must include your name, mailing address, daytime telephone number, and an explanation of the relief sought. You may also include any supporting information with your notice of appeal.

Please be aware that all GRAMA requests are posted on our website as a matter of office practice (with personal information, such as address, redacted). We do this to provide transparency and accountability to the public at large.
