Dear Mr. Eames,

This letter is in response to your GRAMA request received July 17, 2021 in which you requested the following records:

- (1) Any and all documentation of the OSA "consulting" the SRC regarding SWAP and my Appeal Req. # 2021-61, -64 and -65 to the SRC,*
- (2) Any and all documentation of the OSA's final interpretations of the OPMA with respect to SWAP,*
- (3) Any and all documentation of the OSA's final interpretations of the GRAMA with respect to SWAP,*
- (4) Any and all documented correspondence of the OSA with the SRC in which the OSA determines or states an opinion upon the rights of SWAP to convene secret meetings, conceal from the public the minutes of such meetings, not make audio recordings of such meetings and refuse to open any and all other records of SWAP to inspection by the public,*
- (5) Any and all documented correspondence of the OSA with the SRC in which the OSA determines or states that the public shall be denied notice of and attendance at the meetings of SWAP, denied inspection of the minutes of such meetings, denied audio recordings of such meetings and denied inspection of any and all other records of SWAP,*
- (6) Any and all "flow charts" regarding SWAP which the State of Utah Auditor John Dougall (Auditor) or any other agent of the OSA "impressively" provided to the Executive Secretary of the SRC named Rebekkah Shaw (ES) and which are referred to in the audio recordings of the meeting of the SRC convened on July 8, 2021,*
and
- (7) Any and all other documents other than the "flow charts" which the Auditor or any other agent of the OSA "impressively" provided to the ES regarding SWAP and my Appeal Req. # 2021-61, -64 and -65 to the SRC.*

We currently have records that are responsive to your request items. The records include communications between the State Records Committee and the Office regarding the Office's current understanding of the financial reporting status of the Statewide Association of Public Attorneys of Utah (SWAP). These records can be sent electronically upon receipt of the amount cited in the attached invoice.

Pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-2-401, you have the right to appeal the response to this request to the chief administrative officer, John Dougall, Utah State Auditor. Your notice of appeal must be submitted within 30 days of the above date and must include your name, mailing address, daytime telephone number, and an explanation of the relief sought. You may also include any supporting information with your notice of appeal. Your appeal may be submitted at the address listed below.

Please note that all GRAMA requests are posted on our website as a matter of office practice (with personal information, such as address, redacted). We do this to provide transparency and accountability to the public at large.
