Dear Mr. Eames,

This letter is in response to your GRAMA request dated November 14, 2021 (received November 15) in which you requested the following records:

- (1) Any and all audits pertaining to the finances of the JCC, and
- (2) Any and all audits pertaining to the JCC's compliance with the OPMA, and
- (3) Any and all audits pertaining to the JCC's compliance with the GRAMA.

Your request is denied on the basis of Utah Code § 63G-2-203(8), which provides that governmental entities are not required to process GRAMA requests if the requester has not paid fees incurred from actual costs of providing a record from a previous request. We enclosed an invoice dated August 3, 2021 with your most recent request, citing a \$6.13 fee for the labor required to fulfill your request regarding the Statewide Association of Public Attorneys of Utah (SWAP). Until the amount is paid, we are not obligated to fulfill any additional records requests from you.

Pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-2-401, you have the right to appeal the denial of this request to the chief administrative officer, John Dougall, Utah State Auditor. Your notice of appeal must be submitted within 30 days of the above denial date and must include your name, mailing address, daytime telephone number, and an explanation of the relief sought. You may also include any supporting information with your notice of appeal. Your appeal may be submitted at the address listed below.

Please be aware that all GRAMA requests are posted on our website as a matter of office practice (with personal information, such as address, redacted). We do this to provide transparency and accountability to the public at large.
