*The search for records may be limited to those sent and received between May 15, 2022 and September 20, 2022.*

While we do have some records that are responsive to your request, we have already released those records to the public as they pertained to other requests received. They are available at <https://auditor.utah.gov/about-us/grama/>. We do not possess any additional records responsive to your request.

Pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-2-401, you have the right to appeal denial of this request to the chief administrative officer, John Dougall, Utah State Auditor. Your notice of appeal must be submitted within

30 days of the above denial date and must include your name, mailing address, daytime telephone number, and an explanation of the relief sought. You may also include any supporting information with your notice of appeal. Your appeal may be submitted at the address listed below.

Please be aware that all GRAMA requests are posted on our website as a matter of office practice (with personal information, such as personal home addresses, personal email addresses, and personal phone numbers, redacted). We do this to provide transparency and accountability to the public at large.
