This letter is in response to your Government Records Access and Management Act (GRAMA) request to the Office of the State Auditor (OSA) dated August 10, 2023 in which you requested the following records:

- 1) All e-mail communication (including attachments, email chains and calendar entries) from Jan. 1, 2020 to the present between (a) the accounts of Auditor John Dougall, or members of his staff, and (b) e-mail addresses with the following domains:

 - b. sfof.org
 - c. crcadvisors.com
 - d. <u>libertyinc.co</u>
- 2) All emails (including attachments, email chains and calendar entries) from Jan. 1, 2020 to the present, sent to or from the accounts of Auditor John Dougall, or members of his staff, that contain any of the following keywords:
 - a. "Back to Neutral"
 - b. "Free Enterprise Project"
 - c. "Shareholder Equity Alliance"

We do not currently have records responsive to your request.

Pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-2-401, you have the right to appeal the denial of this request to the chief administrative officer, John Dougall, Utah State Auditor. Your notice of appeal must be submitted within 30 days of the above denial date and must include your name, mailing address, daytime telephone number, and an explanation of the relief sought. You may also include any supporting information with your notice of appeal. Your appeal may be submitted at the address listed below.

Please be aware that all GRAMA requests are posted on our website as a matter of office practice (with personal information, such as address, redacted). We do this to provide transparency and accountability to the public at large.
